


Evaluation and Meeting Information

Band Evaluations for the 2018-19 school year are right around the corner. Evaluations for rising 9th grade will be on May 8th, 9th, and 10th from 4:30pm-7:30pm in the Forsyth Central Bandroom. These evaluations will serve to place students in either Concert Band, Symphonic Band, Wind Ensemble, or Percussion Classes. It's for class placement and section placement!** Evaluations for current band students at FCHS will take place during the school day. Percussionists that want to be in the Marching Band Drumline will <u>also</u> need to come to Drumline Try-outs on Monday-Thursday, April 30th-May 3rd from 4:30pm-6:30pm (MS Students arrive after school lets out). Those interested in Colorguard will need to attend Colorguard auditions April 30th-May 3rd from 4:30-6:30 in the band room.

<u>An information meeting will be held on March 11th at 6pm in the FCHS Cafeteria.</u> We will be covering the details about the Forsyth Central Band Program. This will also be a great time to ask questions to the directors and band boosters.

Here are the Evaluation Requirements:



- Major Scales Students will play F (two octaves), Bb, Eb, and Ab (one octave). Students wishing to be in upper ensembles need to play major scales per the GMEA 9-10 Concert Band scale sheet . <u>https://www.gmea.org/concert-band-scales-etudes/</u>
- 3. Technical Etudes Tempo is fast as you can play while being accurate. Go as slow as you need, but the faster you go, the higher your score, provided it is correct.



4. Sight-reading – A short sight-reading from Sight Reading Factory.
