


## **Evaluation and Meeting Information**

- Major Scales Students will play F (two octaves), Bb, Eb, and Ab (one octave). Students wishing to be in upper ensembles need to play major scales per the GMEA 9-10 Concert Band scale sheet . <u>http://www.gmea.org/band/all-state-band/concert-band-etudes-scales/</u>
- 3. Technical Etudes Tempo is fast as you can play while being accurate. Go as slow as you need, but the faster you go, the higher your score, provided it is correct.



4. Sightreading – As short sightreading from Sight Reading Factory.
